Tournament: NRA Approved Small Bore Conventional Rifle (Prone and 3 - Position)

Range: 100 Yard range located next to the 600 yard covered firing line.

Eligibility: Open to all.

Entry Fee: \$25.00 Cash, a breakdown of expenses is available upon request.

Entries: Accepted by e-mail at least one week prior to the tournament (RONNRA12@AOL.COM).
Entry fee accepted on the day of the tournament.

Registration: Starts at 8:00 AM – 8:30 AM until relays are filled. We have a limit of 10 firing positions, so no more 10 shooters per relay and no more than two relays per tournament.

Classifications: Shooters will be squaded by current classification when practical.

Firing starts: 9:00 AM

Rules: NRA Conventional prone and Position rifle apply.

Note: New rule change for 2014 (small bore kneeling) if you are over age 55. Page 41, Rule; 5.10 Kneeling. NRA and Club rule, (ECI) Empty Chamber Indicators will be used at all times when rifle is not being fired.

Rifle: NRA Small Bore rifle rule; 3.2, 3.3, 3.4 apply.

Sights: Rule 3.7, Metallic sights only

Targets used: 50 Yd Phases – (A23/5, A23/3) 50 meter reduced for 50 yd – (A27/5), 100 yd – (A25/3)

Awards: Cash awards for top aggregate score as well as individual match winners will be given.

Scoring targets: Normally the targets would be scored by the match officials, but since we do not have the necessary personal available for this purpose all targets will be scored by the shooter and verified by your shooting neighbor at the completion of each phase. Match officials will verify scores at the conclusion of the tournament before they are officially report to the NRA.

Preparation and target changes: Shooters will be give 10 minutes for equipment setup and an additional 3 minutes prep time before firing begins. The only exception to this is that shooters participating in the 3-Position tournaments will be allowed 15 minutes for equipment setup per stage. Shooters will have 20 minutes for target changes and scoring for the 50 yard line and 30 minutes for target changes and scoring at the 100 yard line.

Prone matches course of fire (1600): When it is a prone only tournament day, the course of fire will consist of 160 record shots and will follow the format below. All sighting shot are to be taken within the time period prescribed for the course of fire. As an option, competitors may elect to shoot the (A & Dewar) only phases of this match if they feel that they are not physically able or do not have the available ammunition.

Match 1-A, Prone – 50 yards (A23/5 Target) 1-string of 20 shots for record in 20 minutes.

Match 1-B, Prone – 50 yards (A23/5 Target) 1-string of 20 shots for record in 20 minutes.

Match 2-A, Prone – 50 meter reduced to 50 yards (A27/5 Target) 1-string of 20 shots for record in 20 minutes.

Match 2-B, Prone – 50 meter reduced to 50 yards (A27/5 Target) 1-string of 20 shots for record in 20 minutes.

Match 3 – Prone – *Dewar Course*; 50 yards (A23/3 Target) 1-string of 20 shots for record in 20 minutes.

Match 4 – Prone– *Dewar Course*; 100 yard (A25/3 Target) 1-string of 20 shots for record in 20 minutes.

Match 5-A, Prone – 100 yard (A25/3 Target) 1-string of 20 shots for record in 20 minutes.

Match 5-B, Prone – 100 yard (A25/3 Target) 1-string of 20 shots for record in 20 minutes.

Match 6 – Aggregate of scores for matches 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5.

3-Position matches course of fire (1200); 3-Position tournament day, the course of fire for the 3-Position course of fire will consist of 120 record shots and will follow the format below. All sighting shot are to be taken within the time period prescribed for the course of fire. As an option, competitors may elect to shoot the (A) only phases of this match if they feel that they are not physically able to or do not have the available ammunition.

Match 1-A, Prone – 50 yards (A23/3 Target) 1-string of 20 shots for record in 20 minutes.

Match 1-B, Prone – 50 yards (A23/3 Target) 1-string of 20 shots for record in 20 minutes.

Match 2-A, Standing – 50 yards (A23/5 Target) 1-string of 20 shots for record in 30 minutes.

Match 2-B, Standing – 50 yards (A23/5 Target) 1-string of 20 shots for record in 30 minutes.

Match 3-A, Kneeling – 50 yards (A23/3 Target) 1-string of 20 shots for record in 30 minutes.

Match 3-B, Kneeling – 50 yards (A23/3 Target) 1-string of 20 shots for record in 30 minutes.

Match 4 – Aggregate of scores for matches 1, 2, and 3.

Master.....99.50 and above
Expert.....98.50 to 99.49
Sharpshooter.....96.50 to 98.49
Marksman.....Below 96.50

Conventional - Position Outdoor

Master.....97.00 and above
Expert.....94.00 to 96.99
Sharpshooter.....91.00 to 93.99
Marksman.....Below 91.00
