Rules: Current NRA rules will govern the conduct of the match.

Competition: Open to all.

Rifles Allowed: Service Rifle – Rule 3.1, a through e: Match Rifle – Rule 3.3:

Classification: The NRA High Power Classification card or temporary score book will be used.

Categories: A minimum of 5 shooters is required to form a class/category.

Awards: Awards will be given in each multiple of 5.
Competitors may not win more than one award in each match.
Classes and/or categories will be combined at the discretion of the match director.

NOTE: **MUST BE A MEMBER OF THE ASSOCIATION OF NEW JERSEY RIFLE AND PISTOL CLUB (ANJRPC) AND A NEW JERSEY RESIDENT TO BE AWARDED STATE CHAMPION.**

Course of Fire:

- Match #1** 200 yards standing slow fire. 2 sighting shots and 20 rounds for record. 22 minutes time limit. SR target.
- Match #2** 200 yard rapid fire, sitting or kneeling. 2 sighting shots; then 2 strings of 10 shots each, 60 seconds each string with a magazine change. SR target.
- Match #3** 300 yard rapid fire prone. 2 sighting shots; the 2 strings of 10 shots each, 70 seconds each string with a magazine change. SR-3 target.
- Match #4** 600 yard prone slow fire. 2 sighting shots and 20 rounds for record 22 minute time limit. MR-1 target.
- Match #5** Aggregate of matches 1, 2, 3, and 4.

Competitors will be required to score and pull targets. Competitors may provide qualified pullers in lieu of pulling targets. The Match Director is authorized to reduce the match in shots fired or distance due to range conditions. Refunds will not be provided once the match has commenced.
