Rules: All current NRA High Power Rules apply.

Competition: Open to all.

Rifles Allowed: Service Rifle - Rule 3.1; Any Rifle – Rule 3.2; NRA Match Rifle – Rule 3.3; Palma Rifle - Rule 3.3.1; F-Class Rifle - Rule 3.4 (a), (b) ; Midrange (prone) Tactical Rifle (AR) – Rule 3.3.3.

No compensators or muzzle brakes allowed – Rule 3.16.1

Targets: MR-1 and MR-1FC

Classification: The NRA High Power Classification cards or temporary score books will be used

Categories: A minimum of 5 shooters is required to form a class/category.

Squadding: At Statistical Office commencing at 0730 and ending at 0830 the day of the match
Online pre-registration is strongly recommended

Firing commences at 0900.
Range limit 48

Awards: Awards will be given in each category and class for each match.
Awards will be given in each multiple of 5.
Competitors may not win more than one award in each match.
Classes and/or categories will be combined at the discretion of the match director.

Note: Tactical rifles will compete with other Tactical rifles combined into a separate category.

Challenges: \$2.00 per challenge LOST.

Course of Fire:

Match #1 600 yard slow fire. Unlimited sighting shots with 20 rounds for record. Time limit of 30 minutes

Match #2 600 yard slow fire. 2 sighting shots with 20 rounds for record. Time limit of 22 minutes

Match #3 600 yard slow fire. 2 sighting shots with 20 rounds for record. Time limit of 22 minutes

Match #4 Aggregate of Matches 1, 2, and 3.

Competitors will be required to score and pull targets. Competitors may provide qualified pullers in lieu of pulling targets. The Match Director is authorized to reduce the match in shots fired or distance due to range conditions. Refunds will not be provided once the match has commenced.

Empty chamber indicators are required – Rule 3.21

Bolt Closing – All competitors shall close the bolt only when the rifle is parallel to the ground and pointed at the targets or the berm

Competitors are required to use ear protection and are encouraged to wear eye protection. In the pits eye protection is required
