Match Rules: CMP rules will govern the conduct of the match.

Match Schedule: Relays as required. Starting precisely at 8:00 a.m.
Competitors should report with firearms and ammunition to the range one
hour before the scheduled start of the match.

Challenges: A challenge fee of \$3.00 will be charged for each challenge.

Entries: **Entries close 15 minutes before the scheduled Match start.**
Preregistration for the match event is strongly recommended and can be

Participants will be required to sign an Eligibility Affidavit and Liability
Agreement if one is not currently on file at the range.

Entries Limited: Forty for each day

Fees: \$30 Adults. \$15 Juniors.

Awards: Cash awards will not be distributed per class or category winners
in lieu of reasonable match fees.

Use of Electronic Targets: We will be using Shot Marker scoring system in all our matches starting in 2026. Competitors will need to bring their own tablet or smart phone to use during the match. To access, hook up your WIFI to Shot marker, open web browser and navigate to 192.168.100.1 once there, simply select your target number. Competitors will be expected to help with set up, target changing and tear down.

Courses of Fire:

1st Stage: 200 yards slow fire, two sighting shots followed by 20 shots for record standing in a 25-minute block time.

2nd Stage: 200 yards rapid fire sitting, two sighting shots followed by two 10 shot strings sitting or kneeling, 63 second time limit per string.

3rd Stage: 300 yards rapid prone, two sighting shots followed by two 10 shot strings prone, 73 second time limit per string.

4th Stage: 600 yards slow fire, two sighting shots followed by 20 shots for record in a 25-minute block time.

Use of alcohol on club property is forbidden and will result in offenders' expulsion and forfeiture of all fees.

Directions to Range:

Traveling on Rt. 55, exit #24-Rt. 49 E. to Tuckahoe, continue 2.6 miles. Range entrance will be on left.

Traveling north or south on Rt. 50, turn west on Rt. 49, continue approx. 13.8 miles. Range entrance will be on right.

Traveling south on Rt. 54 to junction of Rt. 40, turn left, go to far-right lane, turn right on to Tuckahoe Rd. Continue to right fork-Union Road, continue to dead end on Rt. 49. Turn right 4/10-mile, range entrance will be on right.

Traveling on Garden State Parkway exit 38A Atlantic City Expressway to Camden/Philadelphia. Continue Expressway exit at Hamilton Mall/Rt. 40 W. Continue Rt. 40 W through Mays Landing. You will pass a diner and a WaWa on the right (traffic light at WaWa). Continue to next traffic light turn left and then right onto Bear's Head Rd./Mays Landing Rd./Millville Rd. Continue several miles, crossing railroad tracks continue again several miles to Union Rd. Turn left to dead end at Rt. 49. Turn right 4/10-mile, range entrance will be on right
