2024 Civilian Marksmanship Program (CMP) GSV Matches
April 14, May 12, June 9, July 14, August 11, Oct 13

Match Officials: Match Director: Joseph H. Burkel

Match Conditions: These matches are open to all US Citizen shooters using shooter provided Garand, Springfield, Vintage Rifles (GSV) and Modern Military. All firearms should qualify and be in accordance with CMP Rules, Firearms, Ammunition and Equipment found at the CMP Website: (<http://thecmp.org/Competitions>). Shooters will start with one gun from any of the GSV categories and must complete the match with that same gun. There are no alibis allowed or disabled guns declared. Match competitors will be required to furnish their own guns and ammunition, (some ammo may be available for purchase). Empty Chamber Indicators (ECI) and use of ear and eye protection is mandatory for Match events.

M1 Carbine is listed in NJ as a banned gun.

Ammunition: Shooter provided. A limited amount of ammunition may be available for purchase for match use.

Match Schedule: Relays as required, starting precisely at 9:00 a.m. Competitors should report to the range sixty minutes early with firearms and ammunition.

Classifications: There are no classifications.

Challenges: A challenge fee of \$3.00 will be charged for each challenge.

Entries: Entries close 15 minutes before the scheduled start time.

Preregistration for the match events is strongly advised and can be made by phone or via email. Contact information is included below. Participants will be required to sign a notarized Eligibility Affidavit and Liability Agreement if one is not currently on file at the range.

Entries Limited: Forty for each match.

Fees: Each Match - \$15.00

Awards: Awards will be based upon comparison of fired scores to “cut” scores furnished by the CMP based upon previous years match results. Shooters are effectively shooting against themselves for awards.

Courses of Fire: As Issued Military Rifle Course A

Stage	Distance	Type of fire	Position	shots	Time Limit
Sighting	200 yards	Slow Fire	Any	5	5 minutes
1 st	200 yards	Slow Fire	Prone	10	10 minutes
2 nd	200 yards	Rapid	Prone from standing	10	80 seconds
3 rd	200 yards	Slow Fire	Standing	10	10 minutes

In Slow Fire, only one round loaded and fired, no preloaded magazines.

The times and stages for sighting and 1st Stage will be combined into a fifteen-minute time frame.

CMP rules for the conduct of rapid fire (loading/magazine changes) will apply.

Directions to Range:

Traveling on Rt. 55, exit #24-Rt. 49 E. to Tuckahoe, continue 2.6 miles. Range entrance will be on left.

Traveling north or south on Rt. 50, turn west on Rt. 49, continue approx. 13.8 miles. Range entrance will be on right.

Traveling south on Rt. 54 to junction of Rt. 40, turn left go too far-right lane, turn right on to Tuckahoe Rd. Continue to right fork-Union Road—continue to dead end on Rt. 49. Turn right 4/10-mile, range entrance will be on right.

Traveling on Garden State Parkway exit 38A Atlantic City Expressway to Camden/Philadelphia. Continue Expressway exit at Hamilton Mall/Rt. 40 W.

Continue Rt. 40 W through Mays Landing. You will pass a diner and a WaWa on the right (traffic light at WaWa). Continue to next traffic light turn left and then right onto Bear's Head Rd./Mays Landing Rd./Millville Rd. Continue several miles, crossing railroad tracks continue again several miles to Union Rd. Turn left to dead end at Rt. 49. Turn right 4/10-mile, range entrance will be on right.
