GSV CHAMPIONSHIP 2025 Civilian Marksmanship Program (CMP) GSV Championship Match. September 13, rain date Sep 14.

Match Conditions: Match will commence at 8 a.m. The purpose of the CMP Championship Match is to determine a State of New Jersey Champion in each of the Garand, Springfield, and Vintage Rifle (GSV) categories as well as to determine an overall New Jersey State 3-gun CMP Champion. To qualify as New Jersey State Champion a shooter must be a resident and fire a different rifle in each of the GSV categories. For these CMP Matches, all rifles should qualify under and be in accordance with appropriate CMP rules governing specific rifles found at the CMP Website (http://thecmp.org/Competitions). GSV rifles are to be only "as issued". Match competitors will be required to furnish their own guns and ammunition. Empty Chamber Indicators (ECI) are required and use of ear and eye protection is mandatory. Participants will be required to sign a notarized Eligibility Affidavit and Liability Agreement if not currently on file at the range.

Match Schedule: Relays will be squadded. Competitors should report to the range one hour prior to start time with firearms and ammunition. Triggers may be weighed, and guns inspected to ensure compliance with the appropriate CMP Rules.

Classifications: There are no classifications.

**Challenges:** A fee of \$3.00 will be charged for lost challenges.

**Entries:** Entries close 15 minutes before the published start time. Preregistration for the match events is strongly recommended and can be made by phone or via email. Contact information is included below.

**Entries Limited:** GSV Championship-30 per rifle.

Fees: Each GSV category- \$15 per match or \$40 for all three GSV Matches.

Awards: CMP Championships: CMP Pin Awards will be based upon comparison of fired scores to "cut" scores furnished by the CMP. A New Jersey State Championship Trophy will be awarded for each rifle and three-gun aggregate. In those cases where the winner of the match is not a NJ resident, an appropriate trophy award will be presented. Each rifle category must have a minimum of 4 shooters to qualify for plaque. CMP medallions will be given to the top 3 finishers regardless of quantity of entrants.

Courses of Fire: New Jersey State Championship (GSV) will use the AS Issued Military Rifle Course A as listed in CMP rule book.

<u>Use of alcohol on club property is forbidden and will result in offenders'</u> expulsion and forfeiture of all fees.
