Entries: Accepted by e-mail at least one week prior to the tournament (RONNRA12@AOL.COM). Entry fee accepted on the day of the tournament.

Registration: Starts at 8:00 AM - 8:30 AM until relays are filled. We have a limit of 10 firing positions, so no more 10 shooters per relay and no more than two relays per tournament.

Classifications: Shooters will be squaded by current classification when practical.

Awards: Cash awards for top aggregate score as well as individual match winners will be given.

Scoring targets: Targets will normally be scored by the tournament staff if available, however persons not firing maybe asked to do this to help out.

Preparation and target changes: Shooters will be give 10 minutes for equipment setup and an additional 3 minutes prep time before firing begins. The only exception to this is that shooters participating in the 3-Position tournaments will be allowed 15 minutes for equipment setup per stage. Shooters will have 5 minutes for target changes for the 50 yard line and 10 minutes for target changes at the 100 yard line.

<u>A- Course of fire:</u> When it is a prone only tournament day, the course of fire will consist of 100 record shots and will follow the format below;

A-Prone:

- Match 1 50 yards (A23/5 Target) 1-string of 20 shots for record in 20 minutes to include sighters.
- **Match 2** 50 meter reduced to 50 yards (A27/5 Target) 1-string of 20 shots for record in 20 minutes to include sighters.
- Match 3 Dewar Course; 50 yards (A23/3 Target) 1-string of 20 shots for record in 20 minutes to include sighters.
- Match 4 Dewar Course; 100 yard (A25/3 Target) 1-string of 20 shots for record in 20 minutes to include sighters.
- Match 5 100 yard (A25/3 Target) 1-string of 20 shots for record in 20 minutes to include sighters.
- Match 6 Aggregate of scores for matches 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5.

B-Prone course; When it is a prone and 3-Position tournament day, the course of fire for prone will consist of 60 record shots and will follow the format below;

B-Prone:

- Match 1 50 yards (A23/5 Target) 1-string of 20 shots for record in 20 minutes to include sighters.
- Match 2 50 meter reduced to 50 yards (A27/5 Target) 1-string of 20 shots for record in 20 minutes to include sighters.
- Match 3 100 yard (A25/3 Target) 1-string of 20 shots for record in 20 minutes to include sighters.
- Match 4 Aggregate of scores for matches 1, 2, and 3.

<u>C-Prone course</u>; When it is a prone and 3-Position tournament day, the course of fire for the 3-Position course of fire will consist of 60 record shots and will follow the format below;

Match 2, Standing – 50 yards (A23/5 Target) 1-string of 20 shots for record in 40 minutes to include sighters.

Match 3, Kneeling – 50 yards (A23/3 Target) 1-string of 20 shots for record in 30 minutes to include sighters.

Match 4 – Aggregate of scores for matches 1, 2, and 3.
